## EXTRACT FROM STUDENT DEBT POLICY - 3. PAYMENT OF FEES

### 3.5 Interruption or early withdrawal from Studies

If a student interrupts or withdraws early from a programme of study, any remission of fees will be initiated by the Centre Manager in accordance with the following rules:

- 3.5.1 If a student leaves before the end of the second week of the course, no tuition Fees are payable, but a non-refundable fee will be charged as an admission fee.
- 3.5.2 If a student leaves after the second week, full tuition fees for the academic year are payable.
- 3.5.3 Withdrawal due to a death case, tuition fees are payable on a pro-rata basis for the academic year.
- 3.5.4 Withdrawal due to a medical reason, tuition fees are payable on a pro-rata basis for the Academic year. Medical reason implies that a student can not continue his/her studies due to serious illness, which must be certified by a registered medical practitioner. Pregnancy does not apply.
